Annual Business Meeting

UMass Cold Spring Orchard Research & Education Center, Belchertown, MA January 17, 2013

The Annual Business Meeting was called to order at 12:05 PM by President Andrew Martin. President Martin offered words of welcome to the membership. Approximately 50 individuals were present.

Secretary's Report

Ninety-three individuals paid membership dues in 2012. An additional 27 had previously committed to the 10-year-membership/matching program with the Massachusetts Society for Promoting Agriculture and the Commonwealth. Their active membership will continue through 2015. Below are the membership figures for 2005-12.

The Annual Business Meeting was on December 14, 2011, at the New England Vegetable and Fruit Conference in Manchester, NH, and the Annual Summer Meeting was on July 16 at the UMass Cold Spring Orchard Research & Education Center in Belchertown, with approximately 100 people in attendance. The Board of Directors met on February 10 and November 28, 2012.

Treasurer's Report

The General Fund began the year with a balance of \$34,038.93. Receipts totaled \$52,868.71, and disbursements totaled \$38,352.29. The balance on December 31, 2012 was \$48,555.35. The Horticultural Research Fund began the year with a balance of \$297,573.28. A total of \$321.77 in receipts and \$1,266.84 in expenses occurred in 2012. The balance in the Horticultural Research Fund on December 31, 2012 was \$328,653.29. In 2012, the Horticultural Research Fund gained 10.4% in value. The Treasurer's Report was moved, seconded and passed. Details follow on the next two pages.

Ken Nicewicz, the Auditor, reported that the Treasurer's Report was complete and accurate as presented. The Auditor's Report was moved, seconded, and passed unanimously.

Other Business

The Marketing (Nicewicz), Legislative (Dowse), UMass Fruit Advisory (Carlson), and Harvest Labor (Carlson) Committees and Trustees of the Horticultural Research Center presented brief reports. Frank Carlson gave a brief report on the USAA directors' meeting.

The Annual Summer Meeting was set for July 10 at Honeypot Hill Orchards in Stow.

Nominations Committee Report and Elections

On behalf of the Nominations Committee, Autio presented a slate of candidates for officers and directors, including Andrew Martin for President, Al Rose, Glenn Cook, and Joann Dinardo for Vice Presidents, Wes Autio for Secretary and Treasurer, Ken Nicewicz for Auditor, and Bill Broderick, Dana Clark, Bob Davis, Alex Dowse, Joshua

Fitzgerald, Jonathan Morse, and Tim Smith for Directors. No additional nominations were received from the floor. Nominated candidates for president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, and auditor were elected. Bill Broderick, Dana Clark, Bob Davis, and Alex Dowse were elected as directors for 3 years.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:30 PM.
