The General Fund began the year with a balance of \$74,100.78. Receipts as of April 4 totaled \$1,927.70, and disbursements totaled \$4,779.05. The balance on April 4 was \$71,249.43. The Horticultural Research Fund began the year with a balance of \$295,344.08. The balance in the Horticultural Research Fund on April 4 was \$280,343.98, for a 2018 change of -5.1%. The Treasurer's Report was moved, seconded, and passed unanimously.
