The Annual Business Meeting was called to order at 12:10 PM by President Ben Clark. President Clark offered words of welcome to the membership. Approximately 50 individuals were present.

Minutes of the December 13, 2022 Annual Business Meeting

The minutes of the previous Annual Business Meeting were reviewed. A motion was made, seconded, and passed unanimously to approve the minutes as presented.

Secretary's Report

After multiple membership renewal mailings, 156 individuals paid 2023 membership dues. Below are the membership figures for 2017-23. With courtesy and life members, the total membership in 2023 was 176.

The Annual Business Meeting was on December 13, 2022 in person at the NEVFC and via Zoom, with 31 individuals in attendance. Directors met on March 9 and December 5, 2023 in Westminster, and the Annual Summer Meeting was held on July 12, 2023 at Honey Pot Hill Orchard with 120 in attendance. The Secretary's Report was moved, seconded, and passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

The General Fund began the year with a balance of \$97,540.52. Receipts totaled \$32,584.97, and disbursements totaled \$24,514.85. The balance on December 31, 2023 was \$105,610.64. The Horticultural Research Fund began the year with a balance of \$263,064.25. A total of \$2,223.56 was disbursed in 2023. The balance in the Horticultural Research Fund on December 31, 2023 was \$301,531.88, a 14.6% increase for 2023. The Treasurer's Report was moved, seconded and passed unanimously. Details follow on the next page. Through email to the president, the auditor (Nicewicz) stated that he reviewed the financial material and found them in good order. The Auditor's Report was moved, seconded and passed unanimously.

Other Business

Legislative (Dowse) and Harvest Labor (Broderick) committees gave brief reports.

Nominations Committee Report and Elections

On behalf of the Directors, Autio presented a slate of candidates for officers and directors, including Chelcie Martin for President, Peter Mitchell for First Vice Presidents, Wes Autio for Secretary and Treasurer, and Ken Nicewicz for Auditor. Gerry Beirne, Katie Carlson, Joanne DiNardo, Joshua Fitzgerald, Al Rose, and Andre Tougas were nominated for directors with 3-year terms. The election followed. All officer nominees were elected, and Gerry Beirne, Katie Carlson, Al Rose, and Andre Tougas were elected to serve 3-year terms as directors at large.

The meeting adjourned at 12:40 PM.
